The Downs Speedway club was originally established in 1966-67 when racing was held at the old Toowoomba Showgrounds and continued there until 1974 when the Royal Agricultural Society announced they would promote speedway themselves. The then members of the club voted to establish their own grounds and in May 1975 the land at Charlton was purchased and many hard-working dedicated people spent a lot of hours working to establish this great complex that we enjoy today. The Down Speedway Club's Charlton Raceway complex was opened on 23 April 1977.

The club ran and operated the venue successfully until the 2013/14 season when become privately promoted by Alan Woods who operated the venue for two seasons until he sold the lease to Made Too Go Pty Ltd (Barry Waldron) in 2015 for the 2015/16 season.

### SPEEDCAR SCENE

Tonight, will feature the running of the GSA Advanced Machining 50-lapper which is the first time it has been held in Toowoomba. There is over \$22,500 in prizemoney on offer with \$5000 to the winner plus \$100 lap money for each lap led.

The favourite is Sydney driver, Kaidon Brown who has had a standout season. Last weekend he won the Sydney 50-lapper to add to his second Australian Championship victory at Murray Bridge in April. He previously won the Brisbane 50-lapper at Archerfield in 2019.

Australian Champions have won this event a total of 9 times out of the 14 races held so far. Brown joins Nathan Smee (4), Adam Clarke (2), Matt Smith and Michael Pickens (NZ) who won the last race in 2023.

Only one Queensland driver has enjoyed victory at the end of the 50 laps and that is Darren Vine in 2017 but that statistic good change tonight. A number of local drivers are 'chaffing at the bit' to collect a large slice of the prizemoney. Harry Stewart, Dylan Menz, Scott Farmer, Rusty Whittaker, Casey O'Connell and Vine plus others are all out to be first to the chequered flag.

Our racing season has been decimated by bad weather with our last local show being in December. Consequently Ryan Harris, speedway event manager, has added the three round Snowball Series as twilight meetings on May 31 and June 21 & 28, to give the division some extra racing, a gesture that is greatly appreciated.

Over the last couple of months Queensland speedcar racing has lost two men who contributed immensely to the sport with the passing of Blair Shepherd and John Dean. Shepherd was Queensland's first Australian Speedcar Champion (1969) while Dean started in speedcars and was president of the association for many years after son Brock joined the division. Sincere condolences are extended to their respective families.

A big thank you to our sponsors GSA Advanced Machining, The Mental Switch, Fwordspeedshop, Nancy Baker (Bob Baker Challenge) and the long list of lap sponsors for the 50-lapper, who help to keep the wheels turning.

### LAST MEETING WRAP UP - 10 MAY (SEDL CONTRACTORS QUEENSLAND SPRINTCAR TITLE)

Toowoomba Speedway fans were treated to a triple treat at Hi-Tec-Oils Speedway on Saturday night with the grand final of the Field the Label Series for 360 LS Sprintcars. SEDL Contractors Queensland Sprintcar Title for the 410 Sprintcars and the V8 Dirt Modified Champion of Champions, Mother nature also wanting to be a part of Saturday nights program providing some misty showers at various times making life frustrating for the track crew, drivers and teams. Thank you for working tirelessly to try and make the racing possible with the help of the V8 Dirt Modifieds to assist in rolling the track back in. Big thank you to the diehard fans for waiting it out and although the end result was not what we were wanting, qualifying and the heats were certainly worth watching.

Luke Oldfield came agonising close to Lockie McHugh's track record of 10.404 when he stopped the clock at 10.996 seconds ahead of Brock Hallet while Tarhlea Apelt was again at her best setting third quickest with Daniel Sayre and defending Champion Nicholas Whell rounding out the fastest five. While in the heats Harry Stewart was the only driver to win both his heat races.

Twelve laps into the feature race despite best efforts, during a red light stoppage showers continued to fall resulting in the title declared a non-event due to not being able to complete 50 percent of the 35 lap feature race. At the time the race was declared, Brock Hallett had a commanding lead ahead of Lockie McHugh, Luke Oldfield and Nic Whell who was on the move forward destined for a spot on the podium and with Jy Corbet and Luke Oldfield running wheel to wheel with momentary swapping of positions it was shaping up to be an edge of your seat finish. The final result meant that rain won the 2025 Queensland 410 Sprintcar Title and that the \$20,000 in prize money would be paid out evenly spread across all 20 drivers that contested the A Main.



The 360-LS Sprintcar feature race was won by Kye Jensen who wrapped up the Field the Label Series. Brodie Tulloch who earlier in the night broke the 360-LS Sprintcar lap record of 11.581 seconds beat home Luke Manttan.



Earlier in the night, David Clark won the Super Rooster V8 Dirt Modified Champion of Champions event from Brayd Stephenson and Kyle Armstrong. Clark started from position five and from the outset was determined to make it to the top step of the podium. From the start Victorian Zeke Edwards led for the first of 30 laps before Seiton Young levelled up shortly after two laps were complete, this time searching for a way through on the bottom line. With the track starting to widen there was plenty of action mid field with 18 laps to run Edwards rolls to a stop in turn one his race over. From the restart David Clark drives straight through the middle and into second as Seiton Young stretches his lead. Clark switching to the high line starts to close the gap driving around the outside of Young

with six to go. Clark put in a sterling drive to claim a well deserved win from Brayd Stephenson and Kyle Armstrong. An emotional Clark thanked Ray Klarich for his support and dedication to V8 Dirt Modifieds over many years and dedicated his win to Ray's wife Elena who passed away after a long illness last Tuesday morning. Elena was a huge supporter of Rays racing and in healthier times enjoyed traveling between tracks and various trips to Perth to spend time with family and friends. The Speedway family sends its sincere condolences to Ray and the Klarich family during this time.




