The Downs Speedway club was originally established in 1966-67 when racing was held at the old Toowoomba Showgrounds and continued there until 1974 when the Royal Agricultural Society announced they would promote speedway themselves. The then members of the club voted to establish their own grounds and in May 1975 the land at Charlton was purchased and many hard-working dedicated people spent a lot of hours working to establish this great complex that we enjoy today. The Down Speedway Club's Charlton Raceway complex was opened on 23 April 1977.

The club ran and operated the venue successfully until the 2013/14 season when become privately promoted by Alan Woods who operated the venue for two seasons until he sold the lease to Made Too Go Pty Ltd (Barry Waldron) in 2015 for the 2015/16 season.

LAST MEETING WRAP UP – 17 MAY (GSA Advanced Machining Speedcar 50 lapper)

Racing got away on time at Hi-Tec-Oils Toowoomba Speedway on Saturday night after a big effort put in from Ryan Harris and the team making the night possible after 62mm of rain fell on the track on Friday night and into Saturday morning. David Whell and his team did an amazing job of putting down a track which gave us some close and exciting racing through the entire night. Massive thanks to all the drivers and teams for supporting Saturday night and to those that helped behind the scenes to make the night a success.

Current Australian Champion Kaidon Brown won the GSA Advanced Machining Speedcar 50-lapper. At first, we thought Brodie Tulloch was a hot chance, he was driving away and looking in control of the race lead until contact with a lap car damaged the

right front of the car. He fought on with an ill handling car but by lap 16 Brown had caught and passed him. Tulloch would fade to finish fifth in the 50 lap marathon that had more twists and turns than a rollercoaster ride. Just past the halfway point Brown had started to open up a commanding lead with Scott Farmer in second and Mitch Saunderson in third. By lap forty Brown had put down the fastest lap of the race, 12.895 while continuing to gain momentum over the next 10 laps showing why he is the two time National Champion brilliant in traffic. He drove a superb and entertaining race winning by 11 seconds from Scott Farmer and Matt Geering

Victorian Compact Speedcar star Aston Rodriguez won the Queensland Compact Speedcar Title. The 16 year old young gun currently holds State Compact Speedcar Titles in Victoria, New South Wales and ACT. Rodriguez started on the front row alongside current Australian Champion Justin Paul, the two getting into a rhythm quickly, Paul keeping the pressure on before spinning midway between turns one and two bringing on the first yellow lights in the 24 lap Queensland Title. Having to start from the rear at the restart, didn't he put on a show, eventually finishing fifth simply just running out of laps for a podium finish. With 21 laps to go Matt O'Neill drops to the bottom and passes Rodriguez. Rodriguez now realizes he has some work to do chipping away lap after lap and with 16 to go was close enough to have a sneaky look around the outside then dropping to the bottom racing wheel to wheel. The racing between the two is intense as they encounter traffic, the two touching wheels on the way through bouncing off each other. With 12 to go Rodriguez drops to the bottom and drives into the race lead as traffic again comes into play this time Rodriguez a little better in traffic and starts to get away. At the chequered flag he takes his fourth State Title in the same session from a hard charging Matt O'Neill and Luke Williams.





The Modlites put on some close racing also throughout the final round of the Everyday Finance Solutions Ultimate Modlites Series with current Australian Champion Terry Leerentveld, Klinton Hancey and Ryan Silcock fighting it out all race long. Leerentveld persisting with the highline eventually dropping to mid track and settling into second momentarily with 15 to go. Silcock moves up quickly to take the race lead as Leerentveld is shuffled back to third as they try to negotiate lapped traffic just as Silcock clips the lapped car of Adrain Reinke sending him skyward and landing upside down at the entry to turn one. Silcock also retired to the infield with front end damage. When the race resumed Hancey led them away from Leerentveld and Cameron Birch. Meanwhile Dean Silcock moves into third and looks good with an inside pass with 7 laps to go. Leerentveld made his move around the outside and into the race

lead just as caution came across the speedway again. Leerentveld had to do it all again and it would come with three to run as he drove around the outside and into the race lead to finish the final night of the series ahead of Klinton Hancey and Josh Leerentveld in a thrilling and action packed race from start to end.

The current Australian Champion Bruce Marshall was the man to chase in the Stow's Transport South East Queensland Championship Series for AMCA Nationals in the end he would have to be content with second on Saturday night. This will be the final hitout in Toowoomba before the Australian Title is held here on May 31st and June 1st. Marshall led for the majority of the race and with Brett Robotham and Matt Hardy in hot pursuit. Locked in a three car battle knowing full well this was their last opportunity for a test and tune before the Australian Title. With one to run Hardy moves into second as lapped traffic comes into play the two race side by side with a lapped car between them and just ahead more traffic to contend with as Marshall is momentarily slowed giving Matt Hardy a clear run to the checkered flag Robert Kynaston would finish third.



In the Forza Global Series for Formula 500s Amanda Chaffey won the feature race from Liam Williams and Travis Wolfgram in the Juniors Blake Duggan was the first to the checkered flag from Cooper Flynn and Zack Hilder.

Congratulations to Kaidon Brown on his dominant win in the GSA Advanced Machining 50-lapper a fortnight ago. The TFH Hire Services King/Toyota was on rails all night and Brown knew exactly how to drive it, leading for 35 laps and setting fastest time of the race on lap 40 (12.895). Scott Farmer (GSA Spike/Stanton SR 11X) worked hard for his second place as Matt Geering (NSW) come on strong late in the race but fell short, finishing third.

The buzz around the pits on the night was Harry Stewart's misfortune, suffering a major engine failure during hot laps.

Stewart was very disappointed for his team but knows he will get another opportunity to race in a 50-lapper in the future.

Seth Atkinson had an adventurous journey to Toowoomba on the night of the 50-lapper when his trailer suffered a failure and obviously was not going to make it up the range. Atkinson organised another trailer from a family member, the only problem was that it was smaller than his own and could only carry the car and some spare tyres. His parents carried the rest of his equipment in their car, and they arrived just in time for him to make engine start. If enthusiasm counts, Atkinson is headed in the right direction.

Last Saturday night the Speedcars raced at Maryborough and after failing to finish the 50-lapper Rusty Whittaker bounced back to get the feature win.



Today is the first round of the Snowball Winter Series an extra two-round series that has been added to the racing calendar after we suffered so many rainouts this season. Racing in the daytime is different to nighttime racing and the teams will have to be on their game to have their car set-ups right for the conditions.



Tonight's 'Hardcharger' award is sponsored by Fwordspeedshop (Graeme Flynn) while the Bob Baker Challenge will see \$500 go to the starting position drawn prior to the feature race. Bob raced cageless midgets in Sydney in the late 1960s but unfortunately passed away in 2023 and his widow, Nancy, has continued this award in his honour.

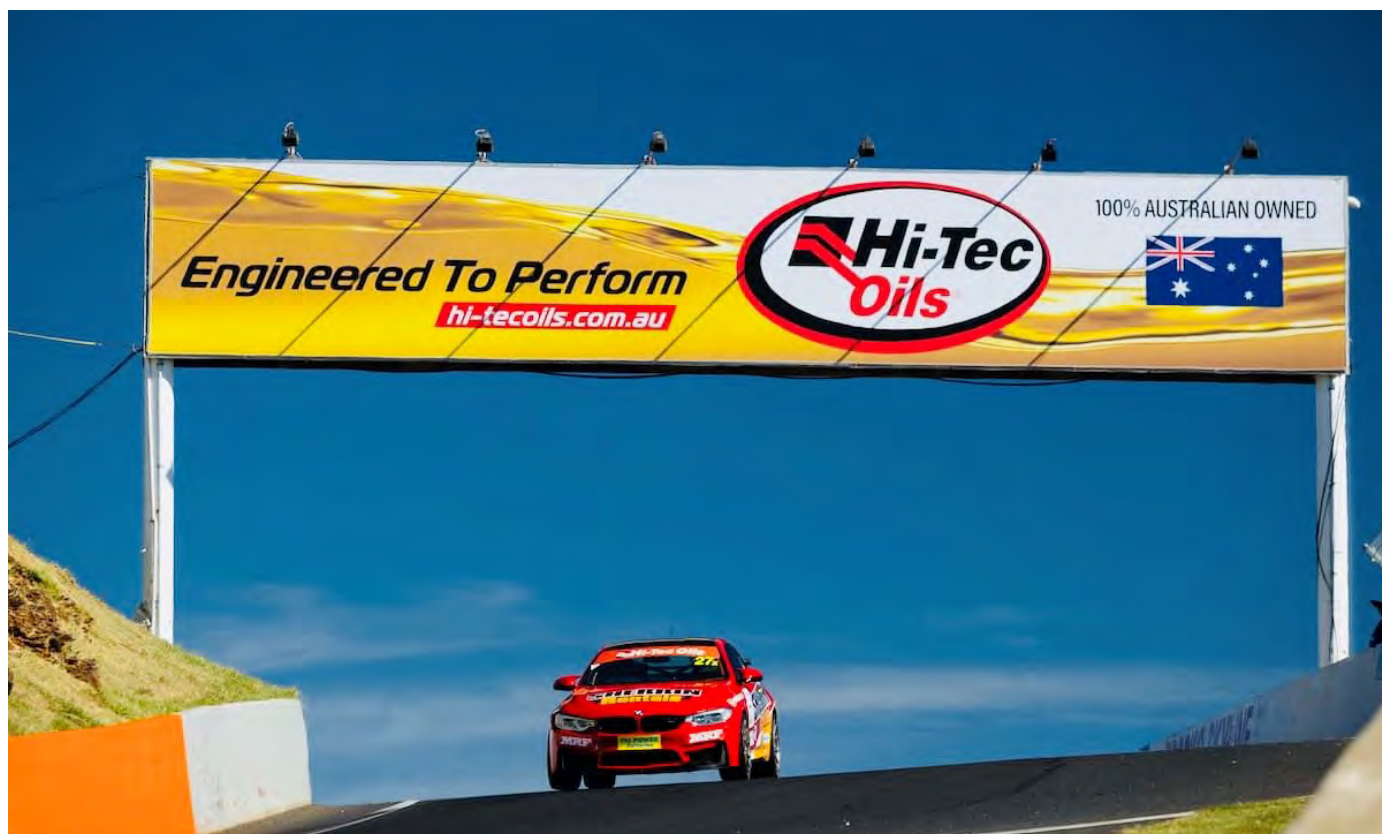
