YOU MUST BE OVER 16 YEARS OF AGE TO UPGRADE TO A PIT ENTRY PASS. THE PIT AREA IS AN ALCOHOL-FREE ZONE AT ALL TIMES AND ENCLOSED FOOTWEAR IS REQUIRED. The Downs Speedway club was originally established in 1966-67 when racing was held at the old Toowoomba Showgrounds and continued there until 1974 when the Royal Agricultural Society announced they would promote speedway themselves. The then members of the club voted to establish their own grounds and in May 1975 the land at Charlton was purchased and many hard-working dedicated people spent a lot of hours working to establish this great complex that we enjoy today. The Down Speedway Club's Charlton Raceway complex was opened on 23 April 1977.

The club ran and operated the venue successfully until the 2013/14 season when become privately promoted by Alan Woods who operated the venue for two seasons until he sold the lease to Made Too Go Pty Ltd (Barry Waldron) in 2015 for the 2015/16 season.



LAST MEETING WRAP UP - AUSTRALIAN AMCA NATIONALS TITLE

At Toowoomba's Hi-Tec-Oils Speedway over the weekend the double header would decide on Saturday night who the next Queensland Champion would be for Lightning Sprints while the qualifying heats for the AMCA Nationals Australian Title would set themselves up for the starting line-up for their Australian Title on Sunday evening. After Saturday night Shane Cartwright on 134 points would be on top of the points ladder followed closely by Matt Hardy on 129, Tony Blanch would follow on 128 with defending Australian Champion Bruce Marshall in fourth on 118 points.

After Saturday's qualifying heats only 20 cars made it through to the main event of the weekend the running of the 2025 Australian Title for the AMCA Nationals they came from far and wide and all parts of Australia to contest their biggest night of the year. The scene was set for 40 gruelling laps Matthew Hardy would start on the front row alongside Daniel Cassidy defending National Champion Bruce Marshall from position three Tony Blanch alongside him. From the start Cassidy raced away with Hardy and Marshall in close quarters by this time Blanch had faded to 5th as Shane Cartwright started to put pressure on Marshall as they entered lapped traffic. Hardy started to move forward but not close enough yet to make his presence felt. Deep in traffic Hardy closed the gap as they tried to negotiate their way through as they raced bumper to bumper just as lapped traffic went three wide. Sending a what's going to happen next message, the two coming out the other side unscathed as we breathed a sigh of relief. While this was happening Marshall was under constant pressure from Cartwright who was searching for a way past. By the halfway mark the racing was intense as Cartwright tried the high line. With14 to run Cassidy moves slightly up track allowing Hardy enough room to drive by and into the race lead. For the next 10 laps Hardy was in control holding a comfortable lead over Cassidy and Marshall when the chequered flag dropped history will recall Matthew Hardy won the 2025 Australian Title for AMCA Nationals making it three for him winning two of those in Toowoomba from Daniel Cassidy and Bruce Marshall.

The Jukes Heavy Haulage Lightning Sprint Queensland Title went down to the wire, just point 221 of a second separated first and second in this year's title feature race. As they formed up for the 25-lap sprint to the chequered flag we knew something exciting was about to happen. Tyler Stralow and Wayne Iacono formed the front row, Keith Blatch and Aaron Seiler were on the second row in a 13 car field. When the lights went green, Jacono got the better start and opened up a handy lead. Then having it all to do again when the yellow lights came on for Sean Iacono who had an encounter with the wall down the back straight. Wayne again got the better start from Seiler and Scott Moir driving around the outside of Blatch and into third momentarily as Blatch went back underneath him, the two raced wheel to wheel for the next few laps. Blatch settles into the groove and starts to move forward quickly finding himself in second with 19 laps left to run, at that point was the quickest car on the race track at 12.516 seconds. With lapped traffic now in the mix lacono now switches to the high line with perfection to clear the slower cars. By this time Stralow had moved into second and all over the back of lacono with Blatch in hot pursuit. Stralow switched to the bottom and has a big look under lacono and makes it work taking over the race lead. Blatch took the same line, moving into second lacono fading to third with 12 to go. Blatch now starts to wind up momentum switching lines eventually settling for mid track as he is all over the back of Tyler Stralow. With one lap to go Blatch drops to the inside for one last chance and levels up with Stralow. Stralow just hung on to win his first Queensland Title by point 221 of a second denying Blatch his fourth in an excellent race which saw Aaron Seiler finish third. Nick Whell finishing 5th in his first drive in a Lightning Sprint coming from position 10, and at one point part way through the race had progressed to 4th.

The Speedcars as always put on some first-class racing during round 1 of the Snowball Series with Scott Farmer becoming the eventual winner from Harry Stewart and Casey O'Connell 3rd while in the Formula 500s Bailey Leeson won their feature from Amanda Chaffey and Bryn Upshall. In the Juniors Zack Hilder was first to finish from Cooper Dawson and Riley Edwards third. Blaine Densley won the Wingless Sprintcar Preliminary A Main from current Queensland Champion Casey O'Connell, Zane O'Toole finished third.

The Wingless Sprintcars put on a brilliant race with Sydney's Jason Bates taking the win from Victoria's Blaine Densley and the Queensland Champion Casey O'Connell the three running the wall for the majority of the race until the track went rubber down in the closing stages. The feature race along with all of the Wingless Sprint racing across the weekend was very entertaining to watch. The Production Sedan feature was one of the better races of the day. Bryce Bayfield the eventual winner from a hard charging Brodie Hollyman and Thomas Fuller the three racing wheel to wheel for the majority of the race. Travis Hutchison was first across the line in the Street Stocks from Luke Wilkinson and Luke Gray. Sunday night being the grand final for the Engage AG Ironman Series. Travis Hutchison took the series win from Darren Ciesiolka and Luke Wilkinson.

The Juniors also put on some entertaining racing with Lachie Burke winning the Top Stars from Tyler Beer and Lawson Clarke third. Archie Evans won the New Stars from Sam Gamble and Liam Guymer third.

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




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
