

COMPETITOR INFORMATION PACK

WELCOME

- Thank you to everyone travelling to support our event at Hi-Tec Oils Toowoomba Speedway which is the venue's 49th season.
- This event is being run by Made Too Go Pty Ltd who promote and operate the Hi-Tec Oils Toowoomba Speedway venue.

SPECTATOR AREAS

- Marques, tents or shade sails ARE NOT PERMITTED in our spectator areas.
- Please keep all marked walkways clear (marked with yellow paint). This includes the yellow lines in front of the seats around the concrete path. Please don't put your seats over yellow lines so spectators cannot access these seats. Do not put your own seats on our concrete paths.
- No smoking or vaping in the spectator areas, there are 3 marked designated smoking / vaping areas marked around the venue.
- **Dogs are not allowed anywhere in our venue.**
- No glass or alcohol can be brought into the venue.
- Please use the bins provided and please clean up after yourselves.

PIT PADDOCK (RESTRICTED AREA)

- Covered in footwear is always mandatory in the pit area (no exceptions).
- It is strongly recommended (not compulsory) that all people entering the pits from the commencement of the race meeting have either Speedway Australia Licence OR a one-day Speedway Australia Licence as it provides you with complimentary personal accident insurance in the pit area (anyone over 12 years of age can purchase a one-day Speedway Australia Licence).
- The pit area is restricted to people aged 16yrs or older WITH ID or must be 12 years or age with a Speedway Australia mechanics card. You must have covered footwear and not be under the influence of drugs or alcohol to enter the pit area. Junior competitors under 12 years of age with a Speedway Australia Licence can only enter the pits if competing in the same event. One day licence holders under 16 years of age, MUST show ID to enter the pits. The only exception to this rule is if you are participating in the Kids in Vest Pit Program (Race Teams only - not general public) please see information about this program on the following page.
- Pit Gates Open at the advertised time on event day. You can access the pit prior to this time, however, 15 minutes before official gate opening time, we will ask everyone to vacate the pits and head to the pit window to sign in for the race meeting. The quicker everyone vacates the pits, the less time you will have to stand in the sun at the gate. Any abuse of our staff and volunteers will not be tolerated and offending drivers or their crew will be asked to leave. EVERYONE MUST LEAVE THE PIT AREA AT ONCE.
- Pit tickets are only available at the gate on the day.
- Pit Walk – General Admission holders (online ticket holders only) will be able to access the pit area until the commencement of the race meeting. At the advertised time, all non-armband patrons with a PIT WALK coloured sticker on their chest will be asked to leave the pits and head back to the general admission area. If you don't have an armband or Pit walk sticker on in the pits between the pit walk times, you will be asked to leave immediately – NO EXCEPTIONS. Our security and staff will be doing the rounds ensuring the correct people remain in the pits. Covered footwear is required in the pit area AT ALL TIMES.
- It only costs \$50 per person to get into the pit area (which includes general admission). The \$50 pit entry covers entry into our pit area / venue (it doesn't include any complimentary personal accident insurance).
- You do not have to purchase pit entry on top of a general admission ticket.
- **It is every competitor's responsibility to understand and know these rules. Any abuse towards any of our gate staff / volunteers or anyone found not following the rules will be asked to leave immediately – No exceptions!**

IMPORTANT TIMES / RUNSHEET

- The online runsheet for our events are available on the Next Event Info section of our website which also includes key times such as gate opening times, driver briefing times etc.

KIDS KIDS IN PITS VEST PROGRAM

- **How the program works:**

- The child (under 16 without Speedway Australia Licence), must wear a high-vis vest during the entire event while in the pit area. If you don't have a vest, our venue has some for sale. The vest must have the car number that the child is being signed in under and be clearly marked.
- The parent must sign a waiver form at Pit Gate on entry to the venue (side window).
 - Must nominate the driver / team – assuming responsibility for child.
- Parent and Child participating in the program will wear armband all night.
- Parent and all Children participating in the program will all pay normal Pit Entry price - \$50 per night.
- No more than 3 children under the control of one adult.
- Maximum of 3 children can be nominated to a driver / team on any given event.

- **Family rules to follow:**

- Children must be supervised and be within 3m of an adult at all times and can only be in their pit bay / transporter, toilet, viewing areas or canteens. Children cannot be in the common areas unless moving from area (passing through with their parent / guardian).
- Children must be in the trailer or not within 5m when race cars are being pushed in and out of the pit area.
- Children must be in the trailer or not within 5m of the race car when it is jacked in the air or being refuelled.
- Children cannot be in a race car when the car is moving or has been started.
- Enclosed shoes must be worn at all times.
- Minimum dress standards in the pit area is T-Shirt and shorts. (eg. No singlets etc)
- The Dummy Grid, Track, Infield and Hotzone are restricted areas for Speedway Australia licence holders only (no children). These areas have been fenced off.

- **Pit Rules:**

- All cars coming off the track must stop in the Hotzone at the STOP SIGN, before moving back to the pit paddock.
- Speed limit in pits is 5 km/h (walking pace) for race cars with clutches, recovery vehicles etc
- Cars without gearboxes / clutches (eg. Sprintcars, Speedcars, Wingless) will be required to be pushed back to their trailers. Mules /Quad rules still apply and must be operated at walking pace.

- **Breaking of any of these rules / regulations, will result in offending parent, children being removed from the racetrack and the driver given a \$500 fine and immediate exclusion from the event.**

COMPETITOR / PIT PARKING

- The Pit Parking Map for each event can be found on the New Event Info section of our website.
 - It details the section where your division is parking at this event or the allocated park you have been assigned too.
- Please nose in with MINIMAL GAPS please (Shoulder width apart).
- Dogs are not allowed anywhere in our venue.
- ONLY TOW CARS with trailers are permitted in the pit area. Camper trailers, tents etc, will need to be set-up outside the pit area in the camping zone.
- Please follow the instructions of our volunteers and park as close to each other as possible.
- Please don't move the drums / bins, as they are your pit bay markers.
- It would be really appreciated if you can all keep your pit areas clean and tidy by picking up after yourself. Waste oil in the marked black drums.
- There is no power in the pit area, so please bring your own generators.
- You must purchase a "Pit Entry Ticket" to enter the pit area. Pit Entry Tickets will not sell out and are only available at the gate on the day of the event.

COMPETITOR SIGN IN

- After purchasing your entry ticket each day, all competitors will be required to sign in at the pit box.
- Drivers will be required to show proof of their Speedway Australia Licence and sign in for the event.
- This needs to be completed prior to roll call at drivers briefing.

INFIELD ACCESS (RESTRICTED AREA)

- Only approved officials by Hi-Tec Oils Toowoomba Speedway who have Speedway Australia Officials licence will be able to access the infield.
- Only approved media (approved by Hi-Tec Oils Toowoomba Speedway prior to the event who've completed a venue media application and have Speedway Australia Media Licence) will be able to access the infield for photography, video, social media purposes.

CAMPING

- Drivers can camp at the track in the pits in their transporters / trailers and take up one car spot only. All other vans, tents, camper trailers etc will need to be in the camping area located in the carpark (Turn 2 / Eastern end of the venue). Camping for spectators is also allowed in the camping zone.
- Camping is Free. You don't need to book camping sites. There is no power to plug into sorry. The water at the venue is bore water and not suitable to drink or run through your motorhomes etc.
- Please keep your pit bays / camp sites tidy and put all rubbish in the wheelie bins provided!
- Showers are located underneath the main straight canteen behind the club rooms. Hot water may be exhausted quickly, so please considerate of everyone else.
- Competitors will be able to gain access to the pit area and/or campgrounds from 9am Thursday, 24 July.

LIVE STREAMING / MEDIA CONSENT

- This event will be available to watch on Clay Per View. A professional production team will be at the event to cover this event. Multiple Camera angles, infield cameras and full production team with commentators.
- A designated social media promotional team will also be covering this event on the Hi-Tec Oils Toowoomba Speedway social media pages.
- You cannot live stream from your phone at the event. You can video and place on your socials AFTER the event if you wish (just not during our event).
- By nominating for this event you consent to media being used, this includes video, audio recordings and photos of yourself, your team and your race car. This media could be used on websites, publications, social media and broadcasting platforms (TV, CPV etc).

EVENT PROGRAM
