



The Downs Speedway club was originally established in 1966-67 when racing was held at the old Toowoomba Showgrounds and continued there until 1974 when the Royal Agricultural Society announced they would promote speedway themselves. The then members of the club voted to establish their own grounds and in May 1975 the land at Charlton was purchased and many hard-working dedicated people spent a lot of hours working to establish this great complex that we enjoy today. The Down Speedway Club's Charlton Raceway complex was opened on 23 April 1977.

The club ran and operated the venue successfully until the 2013/14 season when become privately promoted by Alan Woods who operated the venue for two seasons until he sold the lease to Made Too Go Pty Ltd (Barry Waldron) in 2015 for the 2015/16 season.




AROUND THE GROUNDS – 22 NOVEMBER

Speedcars return to Hi-Tec-Oils Toowoomba Speedway for the Blair Shepherd Tribute Race. In 2025 Speedcars celebrate 90 years of racing in Queensland. The weekend is a great double header with some Sedan action on Sunday afternoon from 12pm. Shepherd was one of Australia's best having 57 feature race wins during his career including the 1969 Australian Speedcar Title, the first Queenslander to do it. He did so much for the betterment of Australian Speedcar racing with his Offy's. He was inducted into the Speedway Australia Hall of Fame in 2011. His foresight along with Bob Morgan driving the second car led to Brisbane becoming the Offenhauser capital of Australia with more Offy powered cars



competing on a weekly basis than anywhere else in Australia during that time. We are all looking forward to having Speedcars back alongside Sprintcars, V8 Dirt Modifieds and Compact Speedcars. This is next level Speedcar racing as we pay tribute to one of the all time greats of Australian Speedcar racing. To add to the entertainment value there will be a 25 lap reverse grid feature just as Blair did at the height of his stellar career where the fastest cars started from the back. On Saturday night Blair's son and daughter Scott and Debbie will present the Blair Shepherd trophies for first, second and third.



Sprintcars are back for round 4 of the Queensland Speedway Spares Ultimate Sprintcar Championship. This round again pays \$5,000 to win and is another 2-heat format night. Both heats will be inverted so the fastest drivers will come from the back to keep us all entertained before a 30-lap feature race which based on previous rounds will have the crowd on their feet.

After rain forced postponement on what was shaping up to be one of the best V8 Dirt Modified Classics they are back again this weekend with good car counts and plenty of exciting racing assured. The V8 Dirt Modified Super Rooster Classic paying \$5,000 to win, thanks to Ray Klarich from Super Rooster for making Saturday nights action

The Super Rooster Classic has become one of the more prestigious events on the V8 Dirt Modified calendar sought after by drivers and race fans alike. 



SPEEDCAR SCENE

Tonight, the QSRA Heritage Series honours a true champion of speedcar racing, Blair Shepherd who passed away in April. Not only was he a star in Queensland but also across Australia and New Zealand winning many big races. He believed to be the best you had to beat the best.

He was the first driver in Brisbane to own an American Offenhauser powered car and over his career he would own many of them. Shepherd was successful in business operating Performance Cars that dealt in used sports and performance cars that was located near the Exhibition Speedway. He became the first Brisbane driver to



win the World Derby at the Exhibition track, the biggest race of the season and held annually since 1946. It was 1965 and he broke the 50-lap record and repeated the win the following season. This event always included many of the big names from interstate as well as the visiting Americans.

When the National Speedcar Championship Series commenced in 1964-65 Shepherd finished third. During the next four seasons he achieved a third and a second before he won the National Championship in 1969, the first Queenslander to do so. He contested the championship for the last time in 1969-70 finishing second to team-mate, Bob Morgan.

Shepherd was a man who could have an idea and then find a way to make it happen. He built a tourist resort in North Queensland and introduced BMX into Australia building a track just down the street from his car yard.

Not only was he great competitor but also had a flamboyant personality who had a huge fan following. Shepherd was good for speedway and speedway was good for Shepherd. His high profile and media exposure helped to make him very successful in



business. Blair Shepherd was inducted into the Australian Speedway Hall of Fame in 2011.

The nominations include Scott Farmer and Rusty Whittaker who already have feature wins this season and joining them are Casey O'Connell and Bailey Leeson who made a very impressive speedcar debut at Toowoomba back in October. Add to them Harry Stewart and Michael Kendall, who are making their first appearance of the season, and you can be assured of a great night of speedcar racing.


